What is your ideal CDM base on your experience

- ⊙ CDM is a Mechanism to promote cooperation between developed countries and developing countries
- ⊙ to fulfill the commitment under KP of developed countries.
- ⊙ and to support sustainable development in LDC countries to accomplish MDG.
- ⊙ Poverty reduction in communities.

What is your perfect CDM from the perspective of developing country

- ⊙ Promotion renewable energy.
- ⊙ Enhance cooperation (joint venture, public private partnership) or bilateral cooperation
- ⊙ Support to Government's priority (poverty reduction)
- ⊙ Increase social and Economic community (increasing employment and businesses)

What do you want to accomplish by utilizing CDM?

MDG/Sustainable development

1. Reduce emissions
2. Technology transfer/sharing
3. Cooperation

- **Reduce emissions:** Energy sector
- **Technology transfer/sharing:** environmental friendly and applicable/maintainable technologies in country
- **Cooperation :** Capacity building and technology transfer/sharing

Issues associate with rules

6

1. The CDM rules are a compromise (one size fits all countries/large emerging economies, LDC etc.)
2. These rules are more adapted to developing countries with advanced economies, but not LDC as Laos.
3. Small CDM projects in LDCs are risk by delays of registration, due to the increase in requests for reviews of registration and conducting reviews before registration.

Issues associate with procedures

1. Current CDM registration and acquisition of the first issues CERs are getting longer
2. One of the reasons for this trend is the increase in requests for reviews of registration and conducting of reviews before registration
3. The delay in registration and issuance will affect the implementation of small CDM projects in Laos

Proposals:

1. (The CDM EB) To simplify modalities for demonstrating additionality of project activities for LDC (seek for best practice or model)
2. Shorten procedures for review of registration
3. Regional distribution/extension
4. (The CDM EB) To simplify Guideline for Validation of projects
5. Develop specific procedures or criteria for LDC to lend money to cover the preparation of PDD and validation cost from Trust Fund
