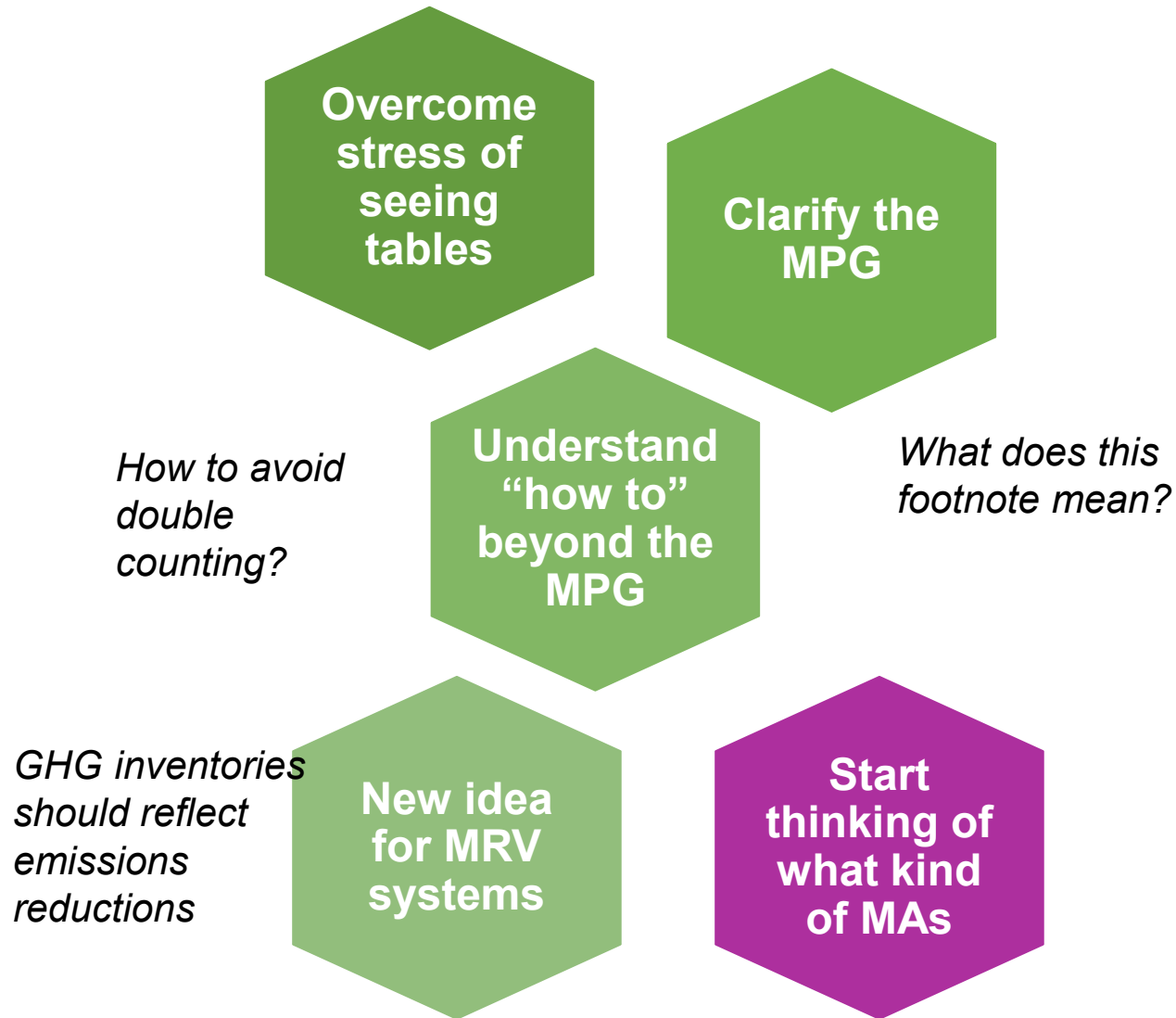

and triggered some thoughts beyond the CTF



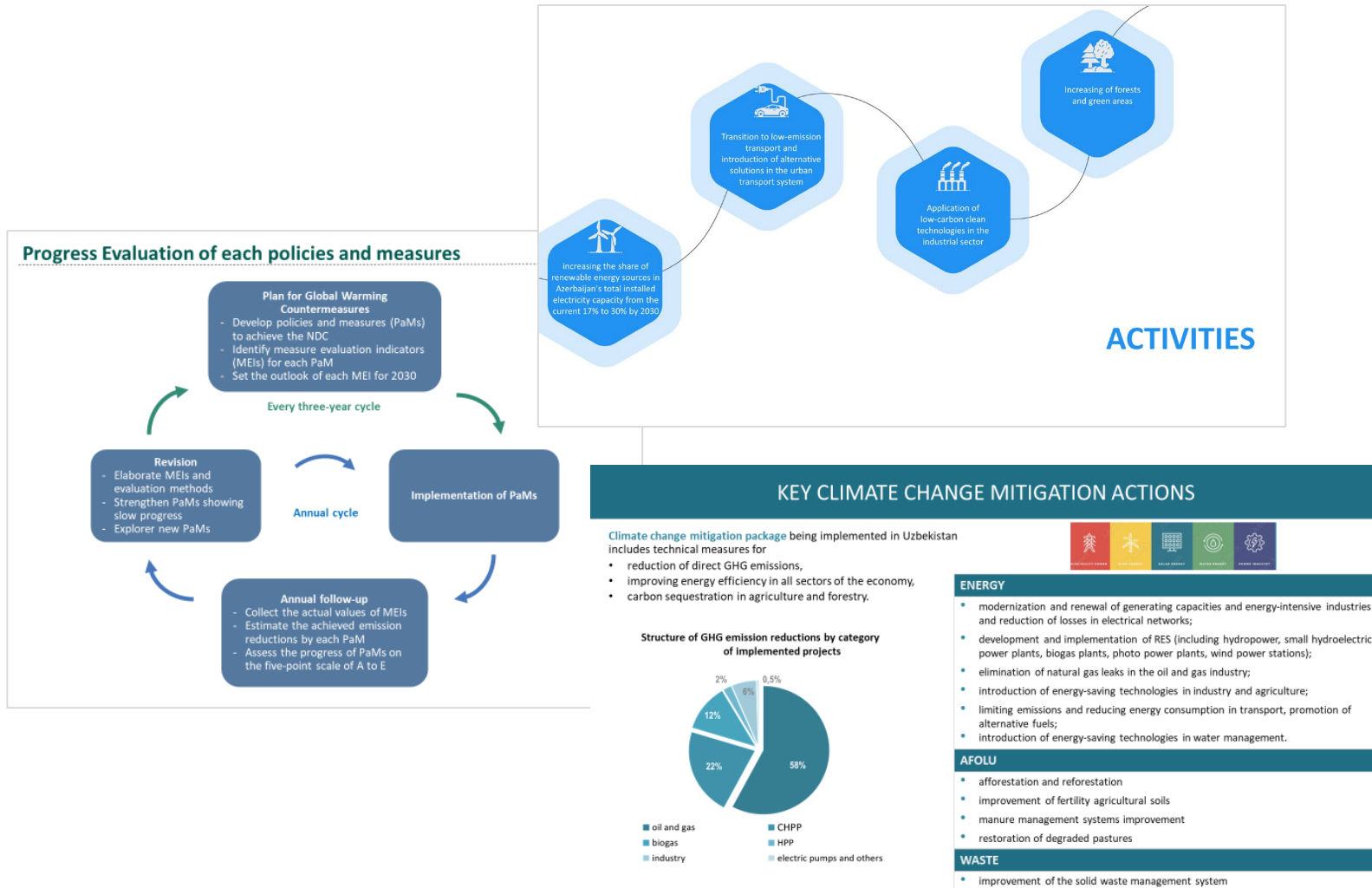
Collaboration with countries and the CBIT-GSP
