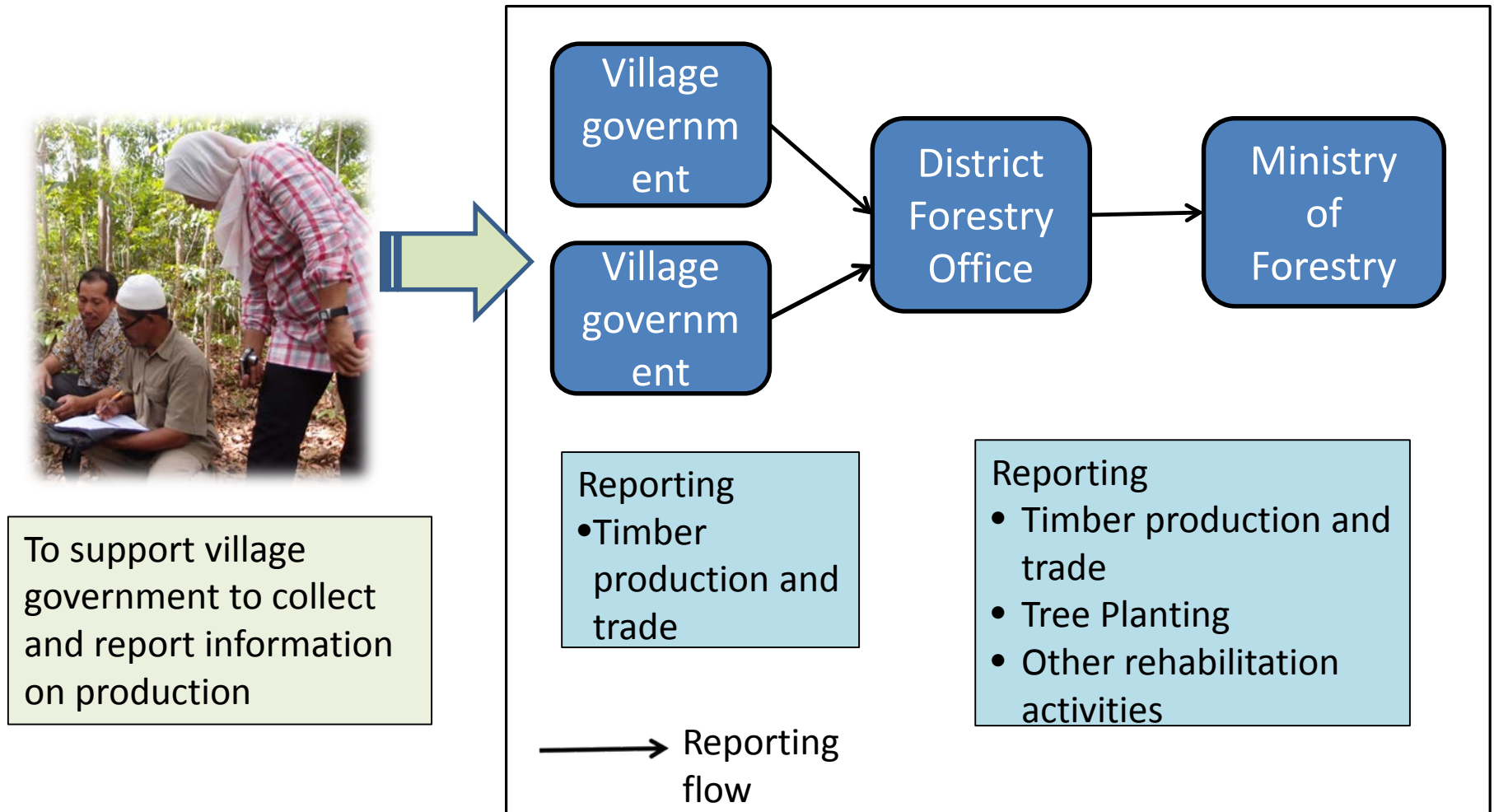

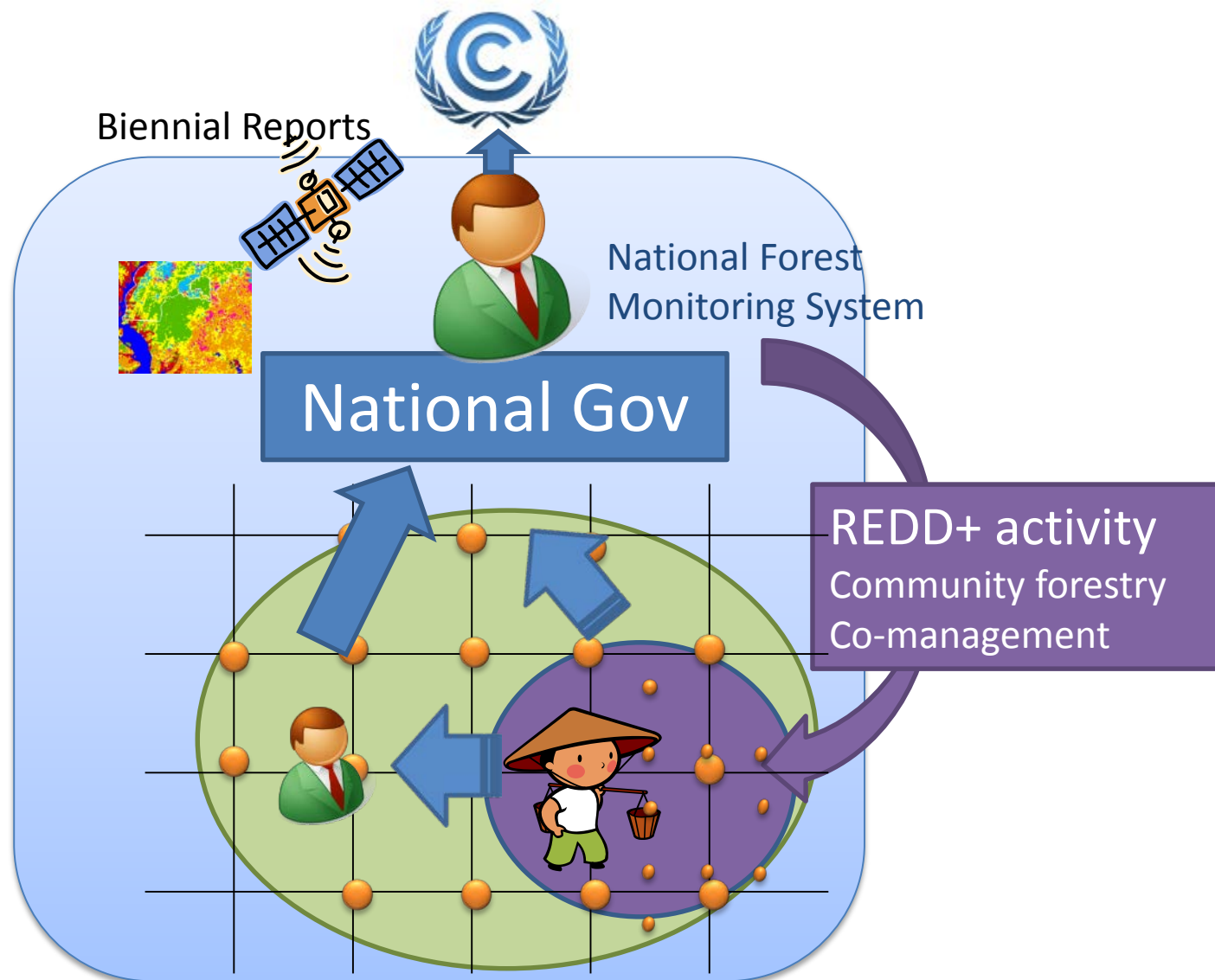


# Link with sub-national forest monitoring system

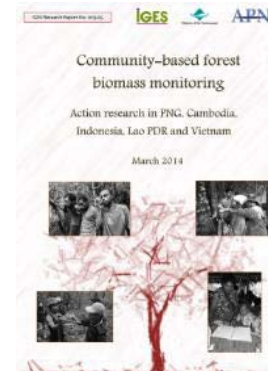
