Strengths of subnational and local government

1. Close to community and field

2. Local independence and creativity

3. Opportunity for strong leadership

Challenges connected to these strengths

Strength	Challenges
1. Close to community	Population outflow, urbanization, competition from outside
2. Local independence	Not easy to establish unique identity – requires creativity
3. Strong local leadership	Lack of financial resources, affected by national policy
