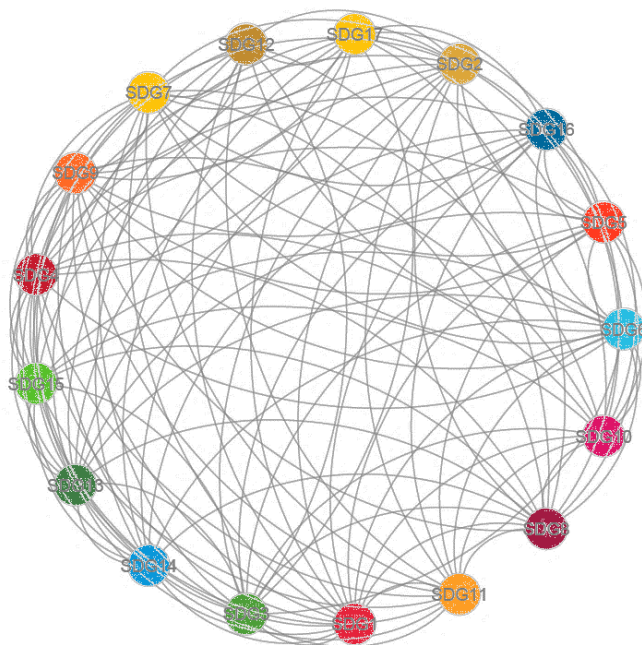


# From Science to Implementation:
