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
Paradigm Shift in Geopolitics brought by ice-free Arctic Ocean

A Change in the Sea Lanes Melting Arctic Ice




Sea Lane+Sea Lane+=Sea Circle






8 shaped infinite Sea Circle going around the world










The deployment of the Baltic Fleet at the Russo-Japanese War The main forces = blue route The auxiliary forces = red route



Asia-Pacific as the Geopolitical Pivot New Rimland "Arctic Maritime Corridor"



New Rimland, "Arctic Maritime Corridor"

- brings prosperous and a well shaped governance to the Asia-Pacific

Or

- cuts possibility of connection for further development and / or
- brings another security threat to the Asia-Pacific

Depends on the security environment of the Arctic Ocean

Security environment of the Arctic Ocean

- Impact of the Russian invasion of Ukraine
 - -- Increasing military activities in and around the Arctic Ocean
 - -- Causing apprehension of accidental arms conflict
 - -- Finland has joined, Sweden has set to join NATO



- -- Prospect for a stage of the 2nd Cold war or armed conflicts
- Disputes over territories, boundary delimitations

How we should ensure safety security environment around the Arctic Ocean

Considerations;

- Generating a world common recognition for the importance of the safety navigation over the Arctic Maritime Corridor.
- Maintaining the stabilized Arctic security environment

Need for securing the Arctic Ocean

Former U.S. Chief of Naval Operations Adm. Michael Gilday called for a massive international exercise in the Arctic similar to Rim of the Pacific at a Brookings Institution panel in Washington, D.C., 7 June 2023

Saying;


The trade routes between Asia and Europe will fundamentally change in our lifetime due to the erosion of the polar ice cap. The Arctic becomes now an area of competition that we must think more deeply about.

Confluence of the two regions

Intensifying trans-regional joint defense exercise / operation among the likeminded nations across Europe and Asia-Pacific

- Joint exercise
 - -- Air Defender 2023, NATO + Japan, in Germany
 - --Coordinated Air Sea drill; France, US, Japan, in East China Sea
 - --Naval drill *Noble Typhoon*; Canada, France, Japan, US, in East China Sea
- Developing new security framework
 - --Negotiation started on a New Security Cooperation Plan among NATO, Australia, Japan, New Zealand, South Korea
 - -- Plan of NATO Liaison Office in Tokyo?
 - -- Adopted the ITPP between Japan and NATO
