## Decarbonization of housing and buildings



- <u>51% from "Commercial and others"</u> and <u>66% from "Residential"</u> compared to FY2013 (Japan's NDC (2021), to be revised)
- Energy efficiency standards will be strengthened to net-zero level by 2030.
- Energy efficiency labeling was introduced, and real estate companies need to display a label in selling/lending housing and buildings.
- <u>Financial supports utilizing GX Economy Transition Bonds</u> are provided including subsidies for;
  - construction of "net zero" level housing and buildings

• replacing windows with thermal insulated models and energy-efficient water heaters (EX. heat

pumps)

- Total amount of major financial supports is approx. 3.2 billion USD in 2024.
- Japan aims to make <u>all housing and</u> <u>buildings acquire energy efficiency of</u> <u>net-zero level on average in 2050</u>.
- A new initiative to reduce whole life carbon has been just launched.
