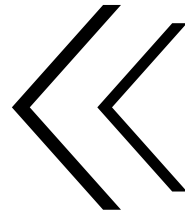
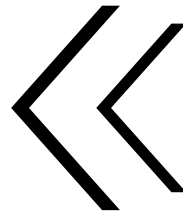


ASIA PACIFIC CLEAN AIR PARTNERSHIP

At UN Environment Assembly-1: For UNEP to facilitate immediate and coordinated action to address air pollution and its impacts and prepare regional assessment reports on air quality issues.



URGENT ACTION NEEDED

Member states reiterated the urgent attention needed to address air pollution with **UNEA 3/8 Preventing and Reducing Air Pollution to Improve Air Quality Globally**

and the important role of regional cooperation with **UNEA 6/10 Promoting regional cooperation on air pollution to improve air quality globally**

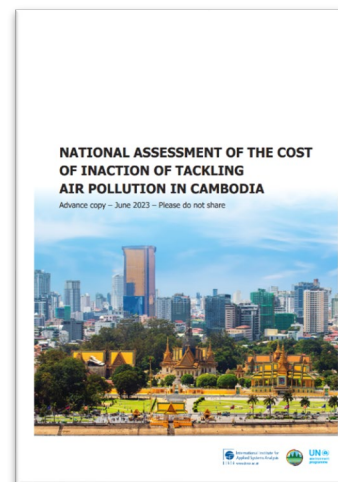
Journey to Clean Air | Example of technical assistance to Cambodia

Overall framework: Developed clean air plan adopted in 2022



POLICY AND REGULATORY WORK

- **Transport**: Implementing improved vehicle emission standards
- **Agriculture**: Resource package on sustainable agriculture practices to address open burning of residues



SCIENCE AND EVIDENCE

- **Overall**: Cost of inaction on air pollution
- **Agriculture**: Remote sensing-based approach to monitor CH₄ emissions from paddy rice
- **Textile**: Assessing emissions from boilers in garment factories
- **Agriculture**: Tier 2 GHG inventory



PARTNERSHIPS

- **Textiles**: Facilitate identification and development of clean air interventions with climate co-benefits for potential access to climate finance, such as Japan's Joint Crediting Mechanism



ADVOCACY AND NETWORKS

- Very active engagement in regional mechanisms on air quality
