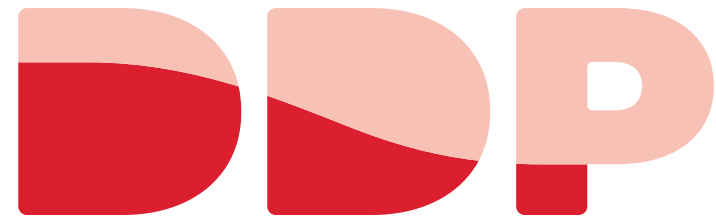

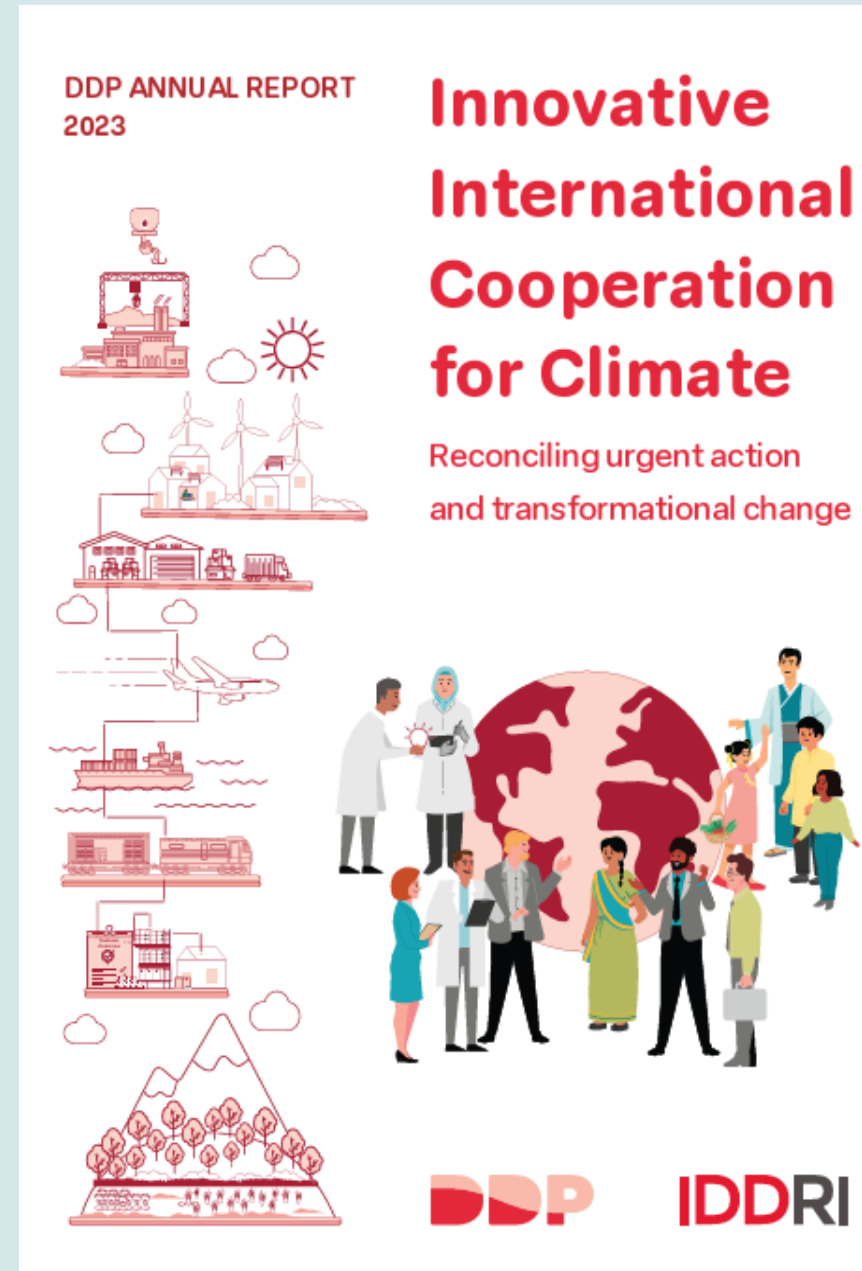
- ❑ An international network of in-country experts coordinated by IDDRI since 2013

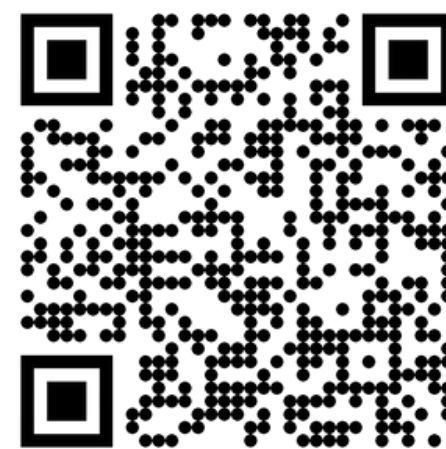

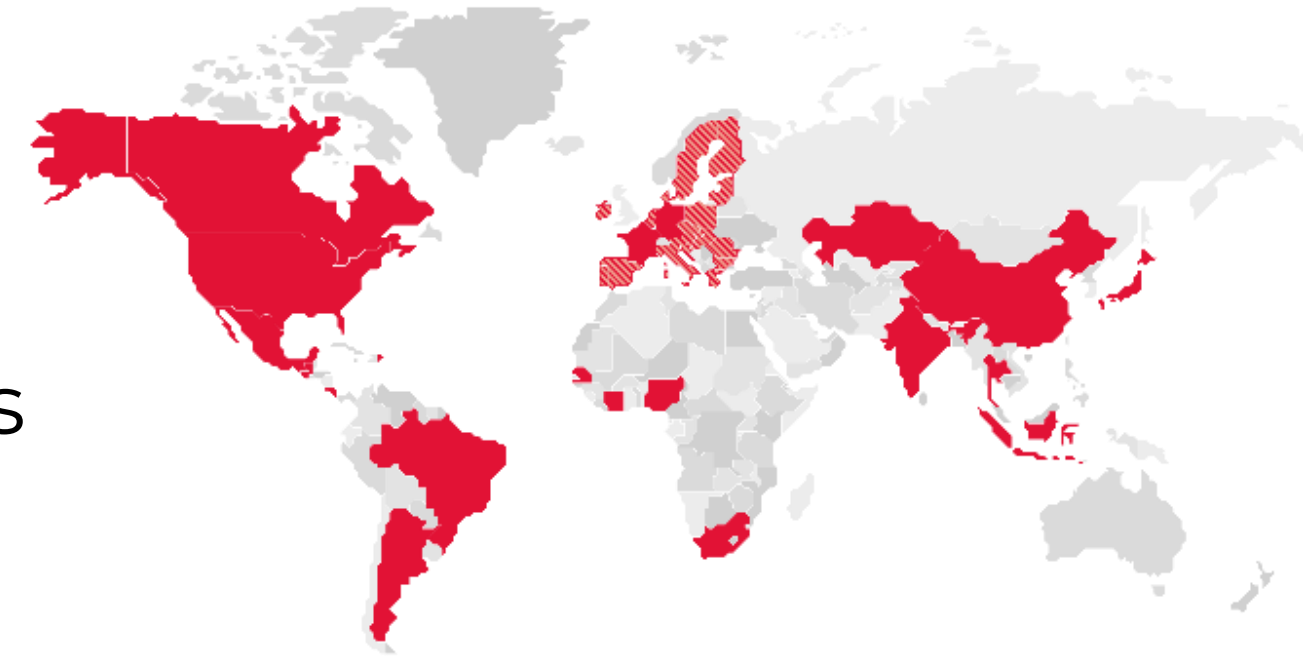

The three drivers of ambitious climate action

- ❑ ***Innovative governance*** organizing inclusive processes, supported by strong mandates, explicitly framed by a long-term perspective and informed by country-driven scientific evidence
- ❑ ***Comprehensive policy packages***, combining a diversity of instruments and measures
- ❑ ***International cooperation*** accurately tailored to countries' needs

Key challenges to effective implementation

- ❑ National long-term carbon neutrality goals and plans do not translate enough into short term plans and tangible policy decisions
 - ❑ Coordination among actors remains too limited
 - ❑ Lack of mainstreaming of climate action with economic and industrial perspectives
- ➔ Key perspectives to put at the centre in the next cycle for enhanced ambition and implementation

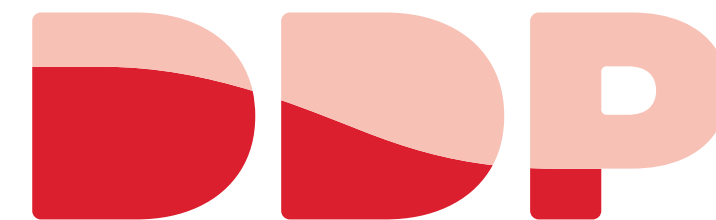
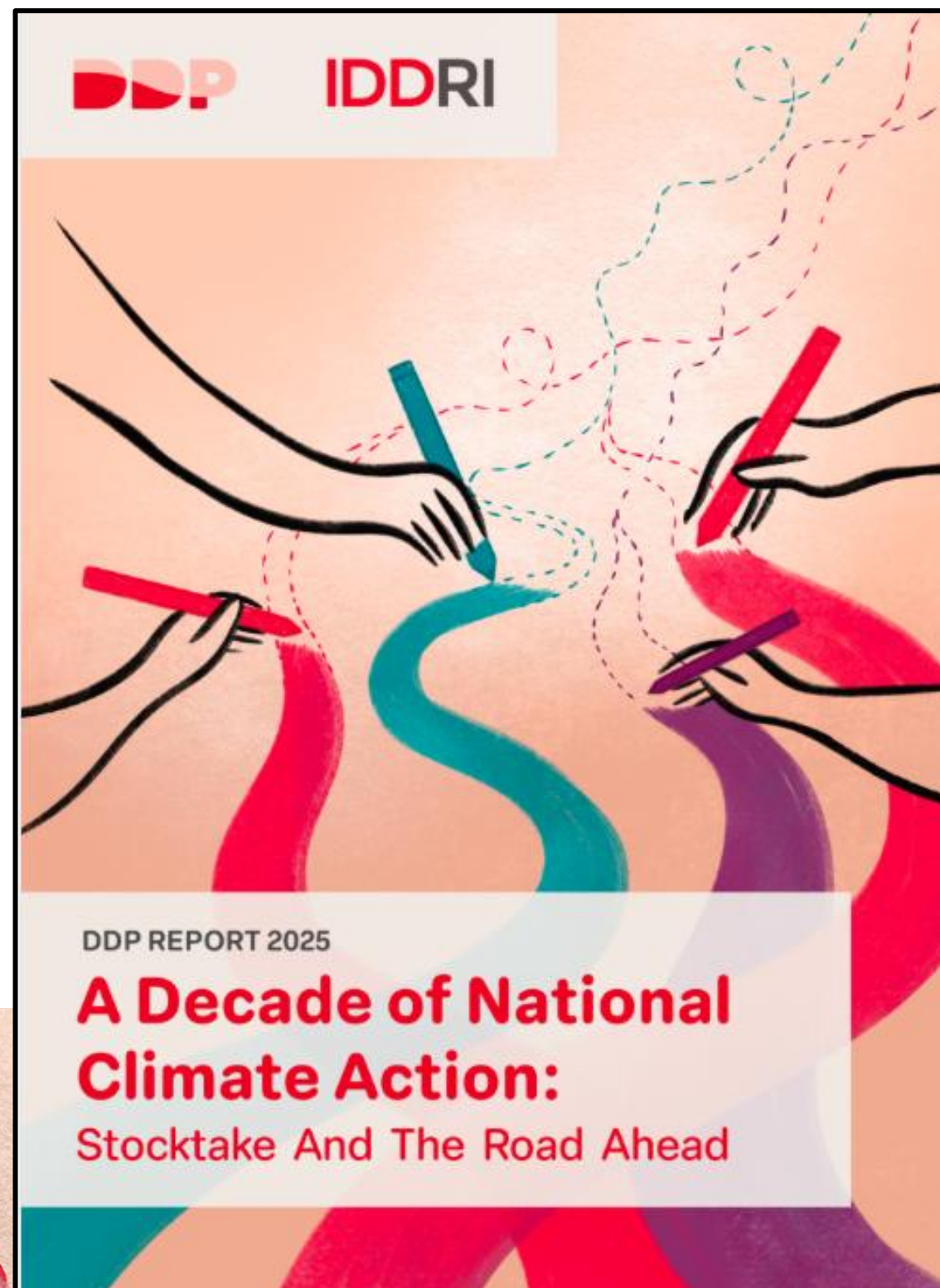
