# Transform Earth Day Tokyo event into a Field for GX Talent Development

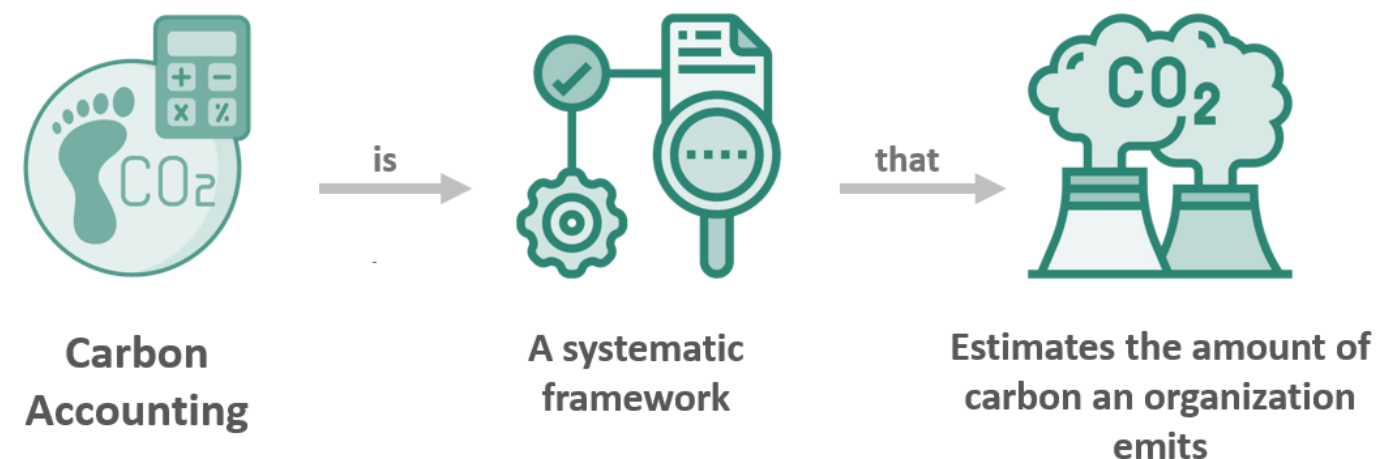
**Program Name** GX Youth Education & Practice Program (Tentative)

**Target Audience** University students and young professionals

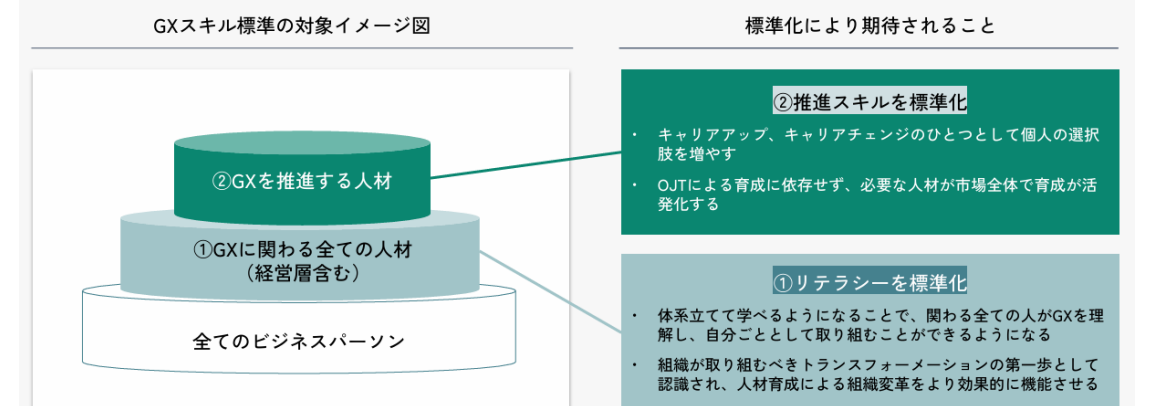
- Program Outline**
