## **United Nations University**

- Established by the UN General Assembly in 1972
- Only one UN organisation whose HQ is in Japan
- Contributes, through collaborative research and education, dissemination and advisory services, to efforts to resolve pressing global problems of human survival, development and welfare
- Serves as a bridge between the United Nations and the international academic community
- Provides a platform for global and local dialogue and creative new ideas
- 13 institutes located in 12 countries on 4 continents



### **UNU Institute for the Advanced Study of Sustainability (UNU-IAS)**

- A research and teaching institute dedicated to realising a sustainable future for people and our planet, through policy-oriented research, education, and capacity development focused on sustainability
- Serves the international community, providing evidence-based knowledge and solutions to inform policymaking and address priority issues for the **UN system**
- Creates new value by integrating expertise across disciplines, in both academia and policymaking, to mobilise knowledge for sustainability
- Only one international institute that offers master's and doctoral degrees

# Postgraduate Degree Programmes

- **MSc in Sustainability** (2-year programme)
- PhD in Sustainability Science (3-year programme)
- Students: currently 38 (19 MSc, 19 PhD) from 19 countries, 76% from developing countries
- Provides education in close collaboration with research programmes
- **Partnerships**:
  - Credit exchange with three universities in Tokyo
  - Double degree with the University of Tokyo (UoT)
  - Joint diplomas with UoT and Sophia University







### Launch of the Postgraduate Degree Specialisation on the Paris Agreement

UNU-IAS announced the launch of the Postgraduate Degree Specialisation on the Paris Agreement in COP26. It will be the first of its kind to be offered by a UN organisation.

#### **Objective**

• To develop future leaders of practitioners who will implement actions for decarbonization and adaptation to climate change in various positions of governments, private sector and other stakeholders

#### **Beneficiary students**

- To be open to candidates from all member states, prioritizing developing countries
- To select from students with bachelor degree, government officials, professionals, etc.

#### Structure

- To build on the existing Master of Science in Sustainability and PhD in Sustainability Science Programmes







Will invite applications from students by the end of 2022 and launch the course in September 2023



## Advantages of the Postgraduate Degree Specialisation on the Paris Agreement

### **Specialisation for future leaders**

Develops future leaders with knowledge and competencies to implement climate policies in each country through the UNU-IAS's postgraduate degree programme for a select few

### Synergy

Develops knowledge and problem-solving capacities to promote synergy between climate and SDGs by taking advantage of close collaboration between research and education programmes

#### Network

By utilising UN organisations networks, collaborates with partners across the world to jointly conduct the curriculum including Practicum (participatory training courses)
