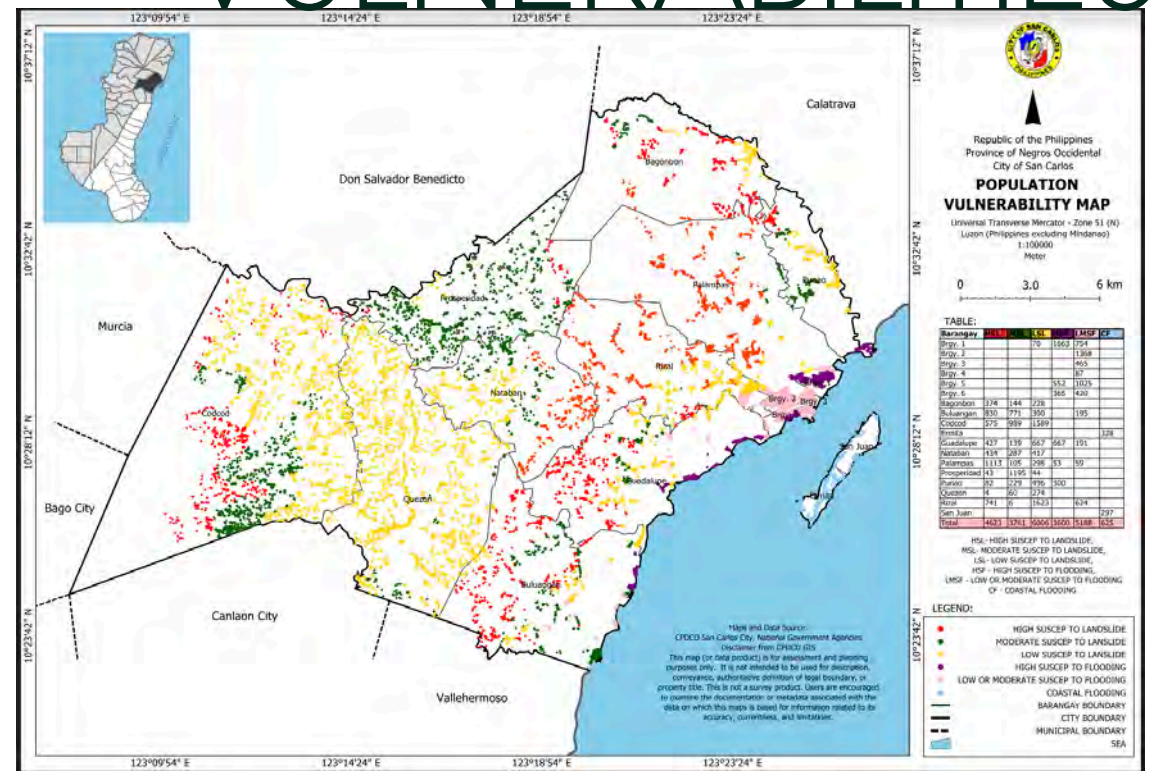
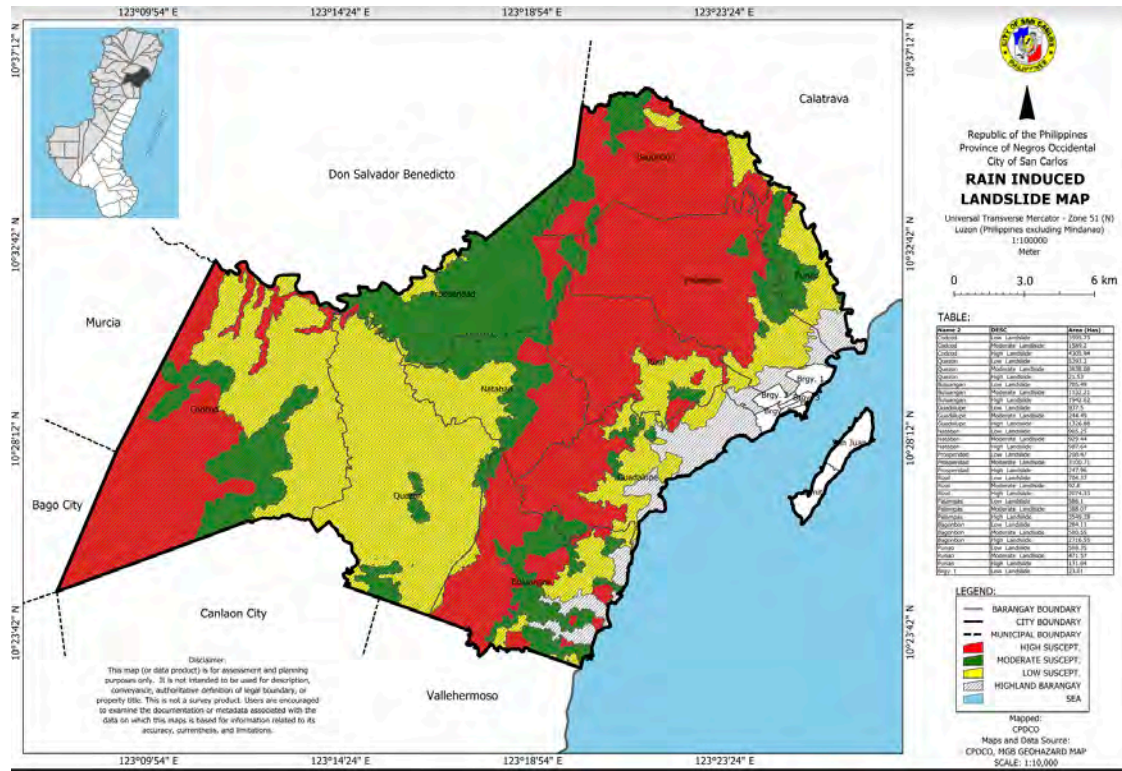

ENABLING POLICIES

2010 

As UN-member State and in support to the HYOGO FRAMEWORK FOR ACTION, the Philippine Senate enacted Republic Act 10121, known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010

2011 



Pursuant to Republic Act 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, anchored on the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA) the City of San Carlos by virtue of City Ordinance 11-08 Series of 2011, "AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF"

2012 

By virtue of Executive Order 58 Series of 2012, the SAN CARLOS CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL was created as a division under the Office of the City Mayor

Subsequently Executive Order 58-A Series of 2012, the SAN CARLOS CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE was created as a division under the Office of the City Mayor

ENABLING POLICIES

2013

With the technical assistance of planning expert from the University of the Philippines Urban Planning, Prof. Ernesto M. Serote, the city endeavored to integrate DRR-CCA to its Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP)

2016

The city approved its Local DRRM Plan to serve as a guide in complying with and localizing the 4 thematic areas of DRR: Disaster Prevention and Mitigation; Disaster Preparedness; Disaster Response; and Recovery and Rehabilitation.

ENABLING POLICIES

2021 

The CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE is being created as a department thru a legislation by the Sangguninang Panlungsod of San Carlos City.

"AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE SAN CARLOS CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE AND PROVIDING FOR ITS TASK, FUNCTIONS, PERSONNEL AND APPROPRIATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

The first local government unit in the Province of Negros Occidental to create a department solely devoted to spearhead Disaster Risk Reduction and Management programs.
