






GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE CLIMATE & AIR QUALITY AIMS



- To reach +2°C max, we need to reach the carbon neutrality in 2050 & compensate remaining emissions with carbon sequestration.
- 2030 Objectives: 50% GES & 40% energy consumption (from 2005 bases) and a 30% share of renewable energy

- Air quality remains a challenge with 4% of the population facing above regulation exposure and 23% in "vigilance" areas
- 2030 Objectives : -70% Nox, -60% particles, -52% COV (from 2005 bases) and the OMS threshold for PM2,5
- Positive impact of measures: Public transportation, Low Emission Zone rules



GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE THE 2020-2030 CLIMATE AIR ENERGY PLAN



AXE 1 : Adapt the territory to climate change (natural risks, urban development, resources preservation)



AXE 2 : Invest in energy transition & air quality (energy efficient buildings and transportations, Renewable energy)



AXE 3 : Share and develop our resources responsibly (waste and water management, land conservation, local food supply chains, wood sector, sustainable tourism)



- → AXE 4 : Involve stakeholders (inhabitants, public services, companies, civil society...)
 - **Axe 5 : Be exemplary** (eco-friendly administration)

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- 4 axes of intervention, 80 priority actions
- A metropole that creates activities & supports innovations
- An inclusive metropole that promotes sustainable employment and the attractiveness of talent
- A resilient metropole, which mobilises economic actors in favour of transitions
- A productive metropole, which supports economic players through responsible development



> A strategy co-constructed with a large and diversified panel of stakeholders

GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE SUPPORT MEASURES TO COMPANIES TRANSITION

GAM is offering support in the multiple areas of transition : clean mobility, energy efficiency, water :

- Free diagnostics (energy, mobility)
- Financial support for thermal insulation of professional buildings
- Financial support for the reduction of water consumption by industry
- Financial support for companies' purchase of less polluting vehicles (2M€/Y budget) in relation to the implementation of a Low Emission Zone (circulation restriction)
- Financial support for retailers energy efficient equipment

GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE CITIZEN CONVENTION

A important participatory process has been settled through the year 2022

- 100 citizen
- 8 months consultation
- **350 proposals** on how to reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 and to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050
- 200 will be worked by the metropole, classified into 9 categories:
 - Housing, development and urban planning
 - Agriculture and food
 - Mobility
 - Consumption
 - Energy production
 - CO2 sequestration
 - Economy
 - Awareness and governance
 - Training and employment



GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE EUROPEAN GREEN CAPITAL 2022 COMPAGNIES ACTIONS 1/2



A one-year program based on the EU award of green capital, 35 companies committed, 150 proposals, among them :



Internal communication to raise awareness about ecogestures on saving, preserving and reducing water an energy consumption, and public transport *for employees*



GRENOBLE ALPES METROPOLE EUROPEAN GREEN CAPITAL 2022 COMPAGNIES ACTIONS 2/2



• Construction of a sustainable mobility area: electric recharging sites for bikes, cars, scooters, provision of e-bikes for business trips, repair station, safety kits.



 Extension of the vegetation on asphalted areas, additional planting of shrubs promoting biodiversity







ACTIONS

- The Horizon Europe programme will provide €359.3 million in seed funding during the period 2021-23 to help deliver on the mission;
- Launch of a Mission Platform to provide technical, regulatory, and financial assistance to cities working on the mission;
- Cities will prepare, sign and implement Climate City Contracts, co-created with citizens and local stakeholders;
- Launch a portfolio of research and innovation projects and set up a Global Knowledge Exchange Centre;




A network of national, local and regional authorities will support the cities' transition to climate neutrality.
