



## Waste disposal sites in Thailand 2022



2,137 Overall waste disposal sites in Thailand

Sanitary landfill	70 sites	60.35 %

Incinerator for power generation	20 sites	17.24 %
Composting site for fertilizers	5 sites	4.31 %
Mechanical and biological treatment system (MBT)	20 sites	17.24 %
In-appropriate site	2,021 sites	94.57 %
Dumpsite	1,707 sites	84.46 %
In-appropriate landfill	216 sites	10.69 %
Incinerator without air pollution treatment system	63 sites	3.12 %
Outdoor burning acivities	35 sites	1.73 %





#### Sources of income



#### Overview of downstream waste management system






