Multiplier effect through **regional dialogues and cooperation**

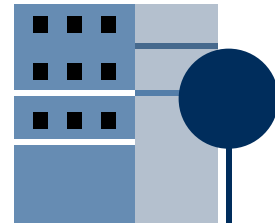


Ambition towards Implementation
