# Article 6: enhancing NDCs

- ITMOs (Art.6.2 and 6.4)
  - Accounting requirements
  - Trade of aggregate results
  - Economic incentives for generating surplus (exporting ITMOs)
- Non-ITMOs (Art.6.4)
  - Specific incentives for certain sectors
  - Development of domestic instruments
  - Climate finance

Require domestic discussions on: NDC implementation NDC achievement Terms and provisions for authorisation (or non-authorisation)

#### Experience of the CDM

- <u>7 July 1999</u>: Ministerial Commission on Climate Change
  - Sectoral policies
  - Legal instruments
  - Additional eligibility criteria for CDM projects in Brazil
  - DNA
  - National policy on climate change
- Projects:
  - 342 projects
    - 55% energy
      - hydro, bio and landfill gas, biomass and wind power
  - Driver of new technologies and expansion of energy sources

#### Experience of the CDM

- Human and institutional capacity-building:
  - Consultants, project developers, auditors and public officers
  - Familiarity with the subject
    - Climate change
    - Project-specific knowledge
  - Institutional gains: climate governance
  - Long-term planning
- Technical and institutional capacity for GHG accounting and reporting
  - 4th BUR on 31 Dec 2020

- Participation requirements
- Institutional arrangements for approval and authorisation
- NDC-related activities
- Infrastructure
- Reporting
- Participation in the review process

- DNA
- Development of baselines
- Terms and conditions for approving projects and authorising ITMOs

### Article 6: capacity-building

- KP X PA
- <u>More</u> roles, <u>more</u> requirements, <u>more</u> Parties, <u>more</u> challenges
- Different institutional capacities
- Capacity-building must be country specific
- What is needed?
  - *Dedicated* and *additional* capacity-building: <u>more</u> resources
    - Institutional development
      - Infrastructure
      - Decision-making
  - Concrete workplan, specific timeline
