Article 6 implementation to enhance NDC and climate action in developing countries

- Involvement of many non state actors: private sector, NGOs, local communities, etc.
- Unconditional NDC:
 - Mitigation activities without CA;
 - Application of CA requests more actions to meet the NDC targets
- Conditional NDC:
 - High abatement costs projects;
 - Funding to achieve the conditional NDC;
 - Issue: application of the CA
- Bilateral agreements;
- Participation in many initiatives in relation with Article 6;
- Subsequent NDCs more ambitious:
 - Inclusion of sectors outside the first NDC

Article 6 implementation to enhance NDC and climate action in developing countries

- Participation in the international carbon market:
 - Compliance market;
 - Voluntary market
- Carbon pricing: carbon tax associate with carbon credit offsetting;
- Cooperation under the Non Market-based Approaches (6.8);
- Reporting framework for ITMOs transactions under Article 6 and the National MRV framework

Capacity building programme for the implementation of the Article 6 and experience of the CDM

- National framework for all carbon market transactions
 - Domestic, compliance international market, non-compliance market, voluntary market: need to manage and report on all activities in relation with the carbon market;
 - Inclusive framework: Government, private sector, NGOs, local communities, etc...
 - Identification and approval of bilateral agreements;
 - Approval of standards participating in 6.2 transactions
- Building capacity for human resources:
 - Identification of potential projects, assessment and approval, authorization, CA, reporting;

Capacity building programme for the implementation of the Article 6 and experience of the CDM

- Experience of the CDM and RCC's achievements :
 - Support DNAs and host countries:
 - Participation responsibilities;
 - Stakeholder awareness,
 - Technical elements: Baseline setting, Additionality assessment, Crediting period, Positive lists, etc...
 - Involvement in the validation and verification process
 - Registries, database, reporting, etc....
 - Transition of CDM activities and CERs;
 - Development of Standardized Baselines
