

















Greenhouse gas emissions on the rise




GHG emissions scenario with compounded Nationally Determined Contributions and carbon neutral pledges in Asia and the Pacific




Emission targets and commitments in line with Paris Agreement



GHG Emissions of ESCAP Member States with Updated and Non-Updated NDCs (GtCO2e), 2019




Growth of GHG emissions, 2010 -2019, (MtCO2e)


