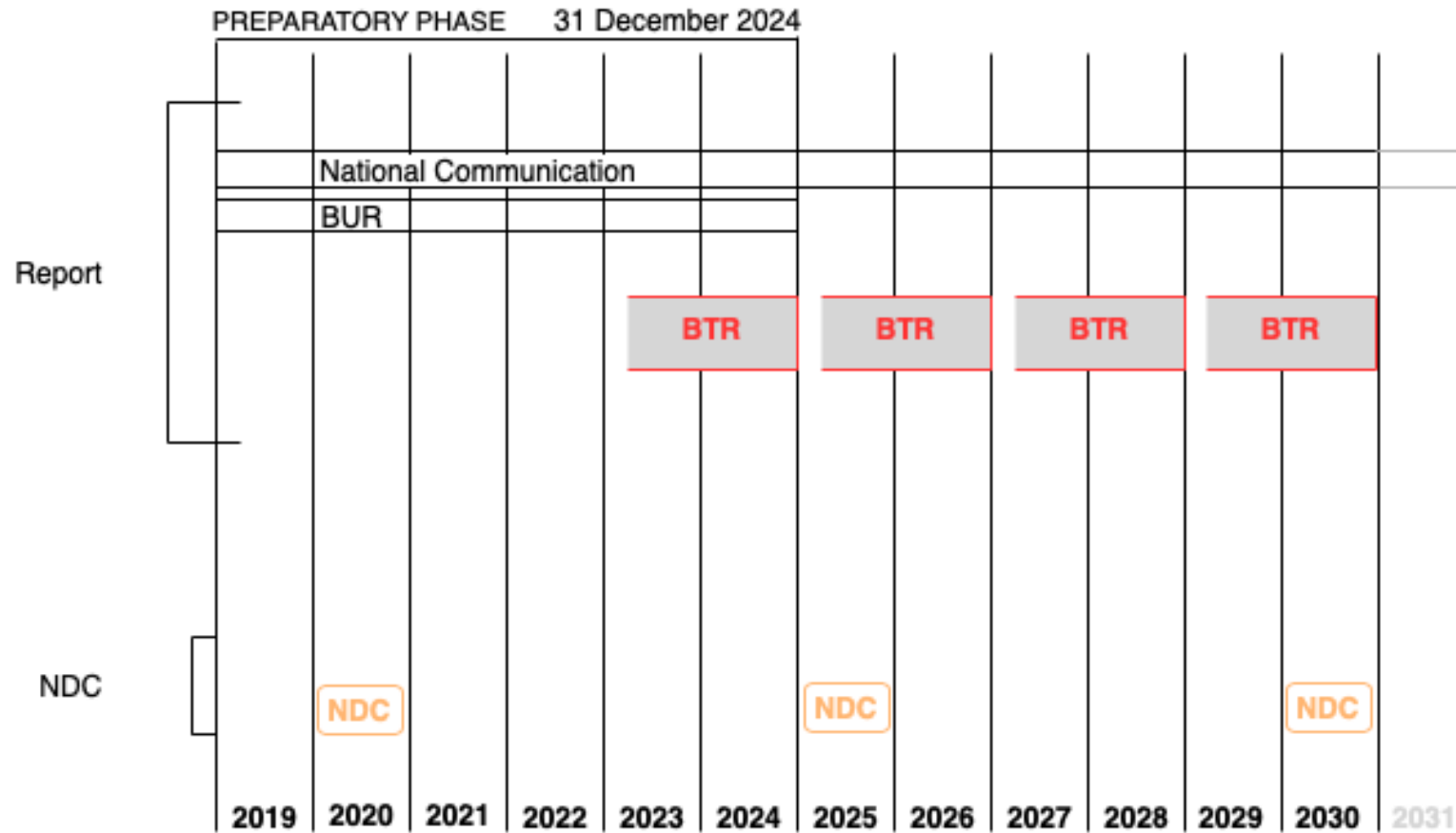

- The CMA 1 urged and requested the Global Environment Facility (GEF), as an operating entity of the Financial Mechanism, to support developing country Parties in preparing their first and subsequent BTR.
- The CMA 1 also encouraged the GEF to consider providing an avenue for Parties to apply for funding for more than one report through the same application in each replenishment period.
- At CMA 2, Parties reiterated their request to the GEF to adequately support developing countries Parties in preparing their first and subsequent BTR under its seventh replenishment (GEF-7) and through its replenishment cycles.
- Two informal consultations on financial support for BTRs were held in June 18, 2020 and in November 17, 2020, with participation of national government representatives, members from the Consultative Group of Experts (CGE), the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Secretariat, and relevant GEF Implementing Agencies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR GEF SUPPORT

- All developing country Parties to the Paris Agreement, including LDCs and SIDS will be eligible to receive financing for the preparation of BTRs.
- Parties to the Paris Agreement may continue to report a separate national communication (NC) every four years, or may choose to submit a single BTR/NC report in the years a NC is submitted


Modalities for supporting the preparation of the first BTR



GLOBAL SUPPORT
PROGRAMME



- **Modality 1:** countries can access up to **\$484,000** for the preparation of a stand-alone BTR.
- **Modality 2:** countries can access up to **\$517,000** for the preparation of a combined BTR and NC.

 will be rolled out from **January 2021**

- **Modality 3:** countries can access additional (top-up) financing of **\$200,000**, maximum, to an ongoing EA project.

 will be rolled out in **January 2023**, in the GEF-8 period

- Parties that choose to prepare a separate NC can access up to \$500,000 from the climate change focal area set-aside. The GEF Secretariat, however, will minimize duplication of resources for common elements across reports supported.

IV. Information on financial, technology development and transfer and capacity-building support needed and received under Articles 9–11 of the Paris Agreement	20,000
V. Other relevant information (e.g. gender) including supplemental NC chapters (research and systemic observation; and, education, training and public awareness)	40,000
VI. Publication and submission of report, and project execution support	30,000
Sub Total BTR/NC	470,000
Project management cost (10%)	47,000
Total	517,000

Modalities for supporting the preparation of the first BTR

PROGRAMME



- BUR support for Parties to the Paris Agreement will be phased out on **January 1, 2022**.
- The GEF will provide support for the first BTR upon submission of a country's last GEF-supported BUR to the UNFCCC.
- Support for the first BTR combined with a NC will be made available upon submission of a country's last GEF-supported NC to the UNFCCC Secretariat

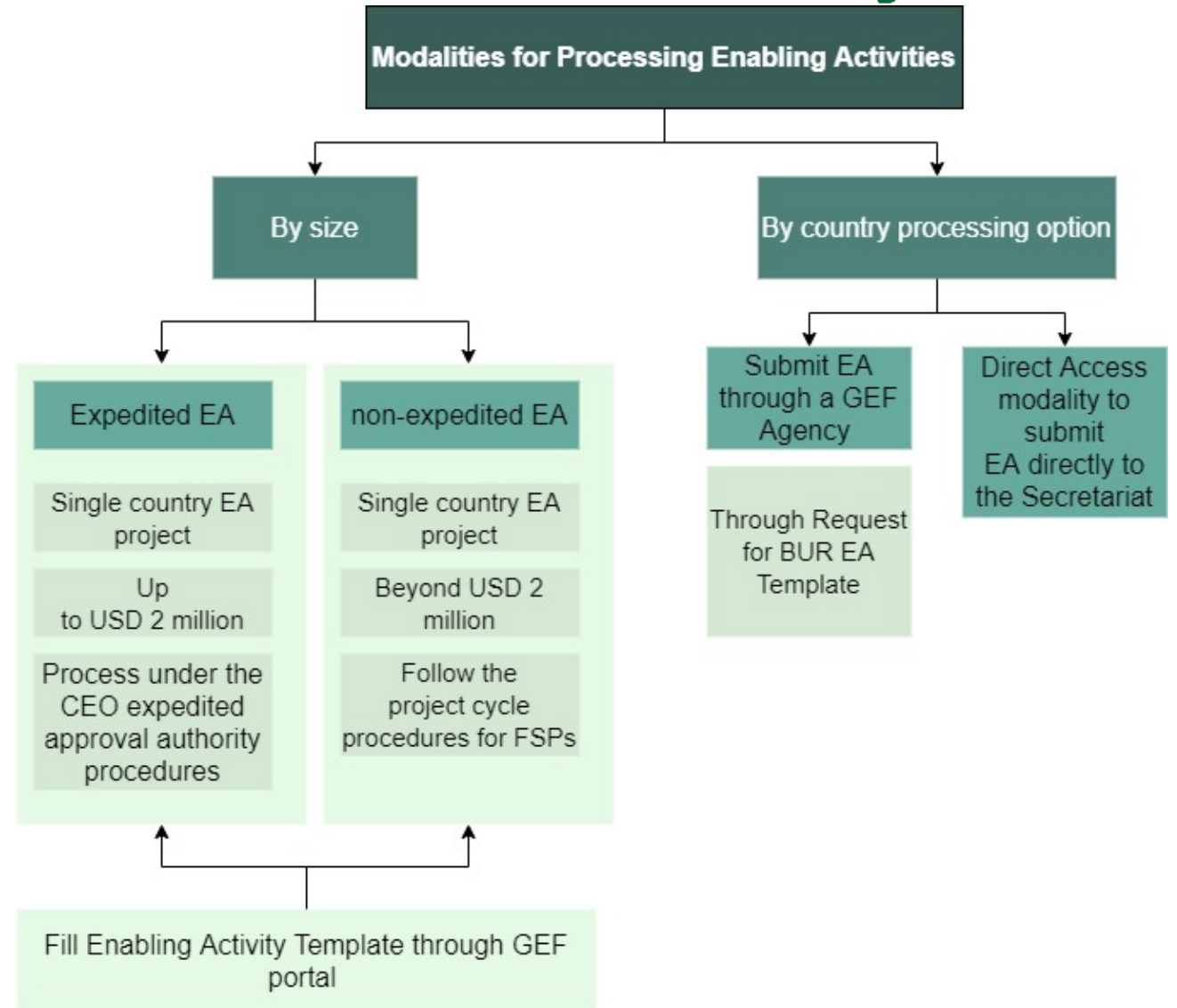
SUBMISSION OF PROJECT PROPOSALS
