1. About the APO

 The Asian Productivity Organization (APO) is an intergovernmental organization committed to improving productivity in Asia and the Pacific through capacitybuilding efforts, sharing productivity best practices, etc.

2. Green Productivity (GP)

- The APO launched the GP concept in 1994 under the special cash grant of the Government of Japan to enhance productivity and simultaneously reduce negative impacts on the environment.
- The APO has propagated the GP concept and its framework through capacity-building projects, establishment of a Center of Excellence on GP, demonstration projects, and research.

3. Focused areas of GP

• The GP framework, which includes the 3Rs of reuse, reduce, and recycle, design for environment, ecodesign, and green supply chains, also contributes to the pursuit of a circular economy.
