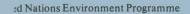

#### Stockholm 1972: Milestones

- Led to the creation of the United Nations Environmental Programme (UNEP)
- Motivated countries to form national environmental ministries and agencies
- Set the stage for a series of high-level conferences and summits, including
  - United Nations Conference on Environment and Development in 1992;
  - World Summit on Sustainable Development in 2002; and
  - United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012

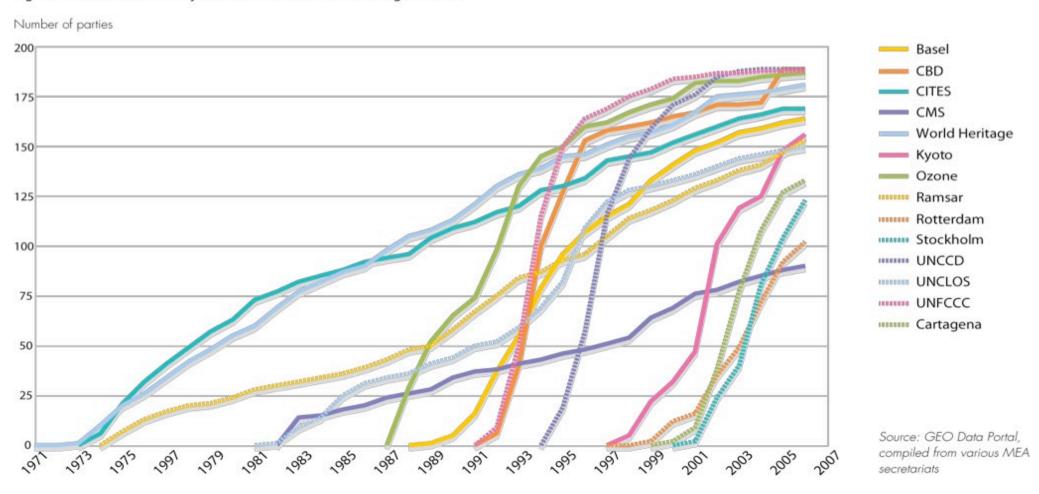
Stockholm Declaration

#### Principle 21

States have, in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law, the sovereign right to exploit their own resources pursuant to their own environmental policies, and the responsibility to ensure that activities within their jurisdiction or control do not cause damage to the environment of other States or of areas beyond the limits of national jurisdiction.

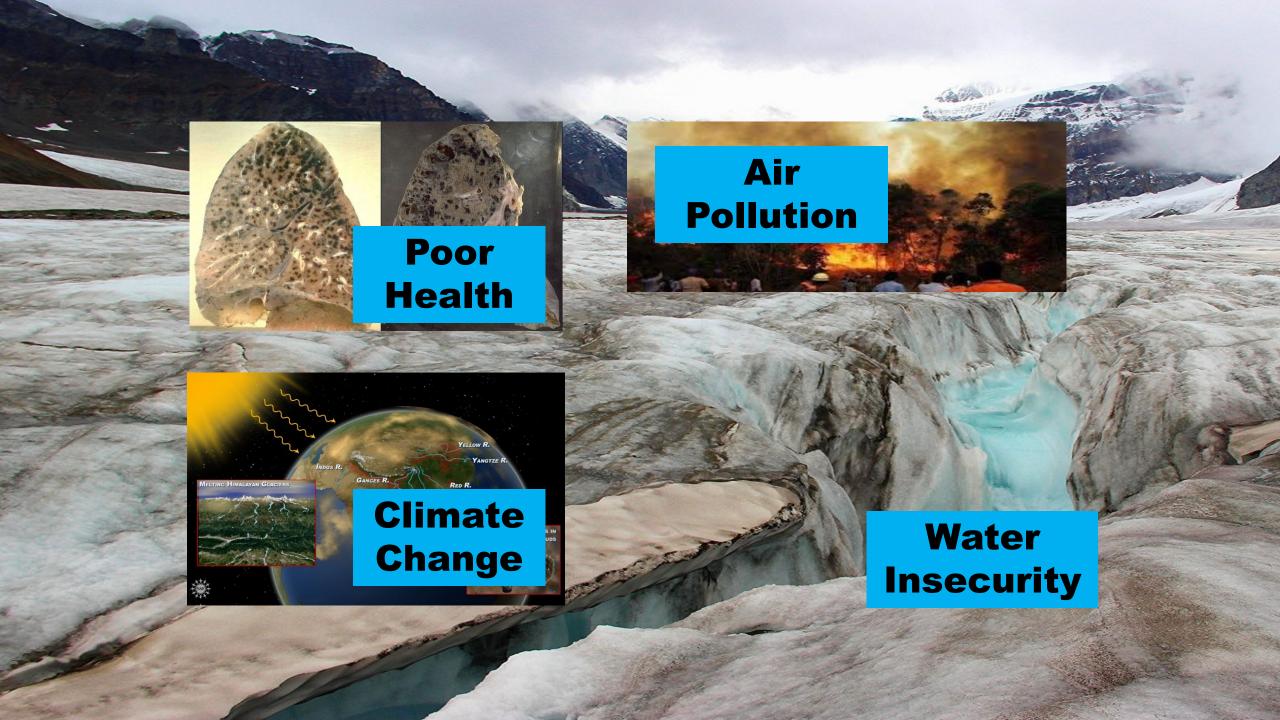

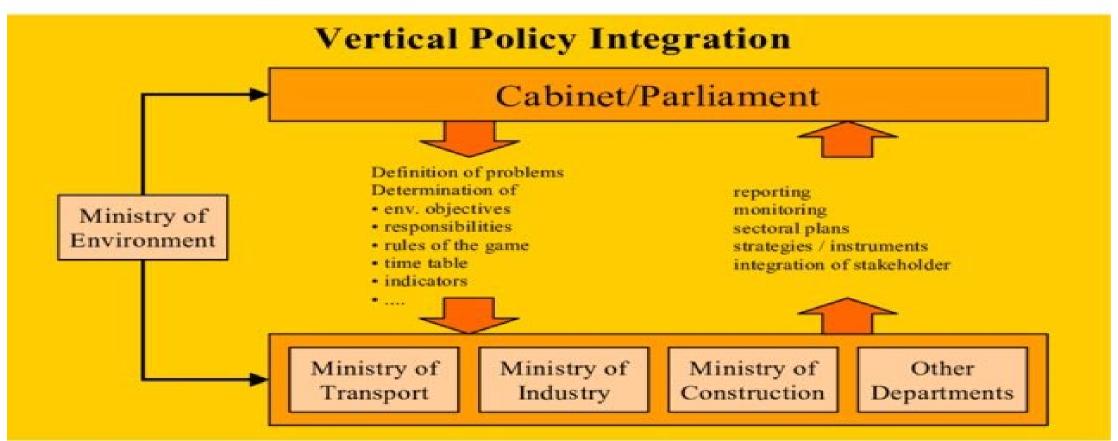
#### Principle 13
