




COVID-19 Challenges in Education system – Focus on Geoscience









 Outbreak of COVID-19, Universities and Scientific Institutes have shut down, which restricted their geological activities.




 Geoscience educators and researchers need to adopt rapidly to this 'new norm' for continuing their activities in the absence of field and laboratory access.




Transition from traditional learning to online mode.
