



Asian Marine Plastic litter Workshop



- BTB is secondary city located in Western of Cambodia . There are 10 communes ,62 villages , about 160.000 inhabitants
- more than 160.000 inhabitants
- SWM 240 tons/day
- waste 15 % plastic waste
- about 5 % plastic waste recycled at BPP
- Waste collected by Private contractors (Cintri and Leap Lem companies)
